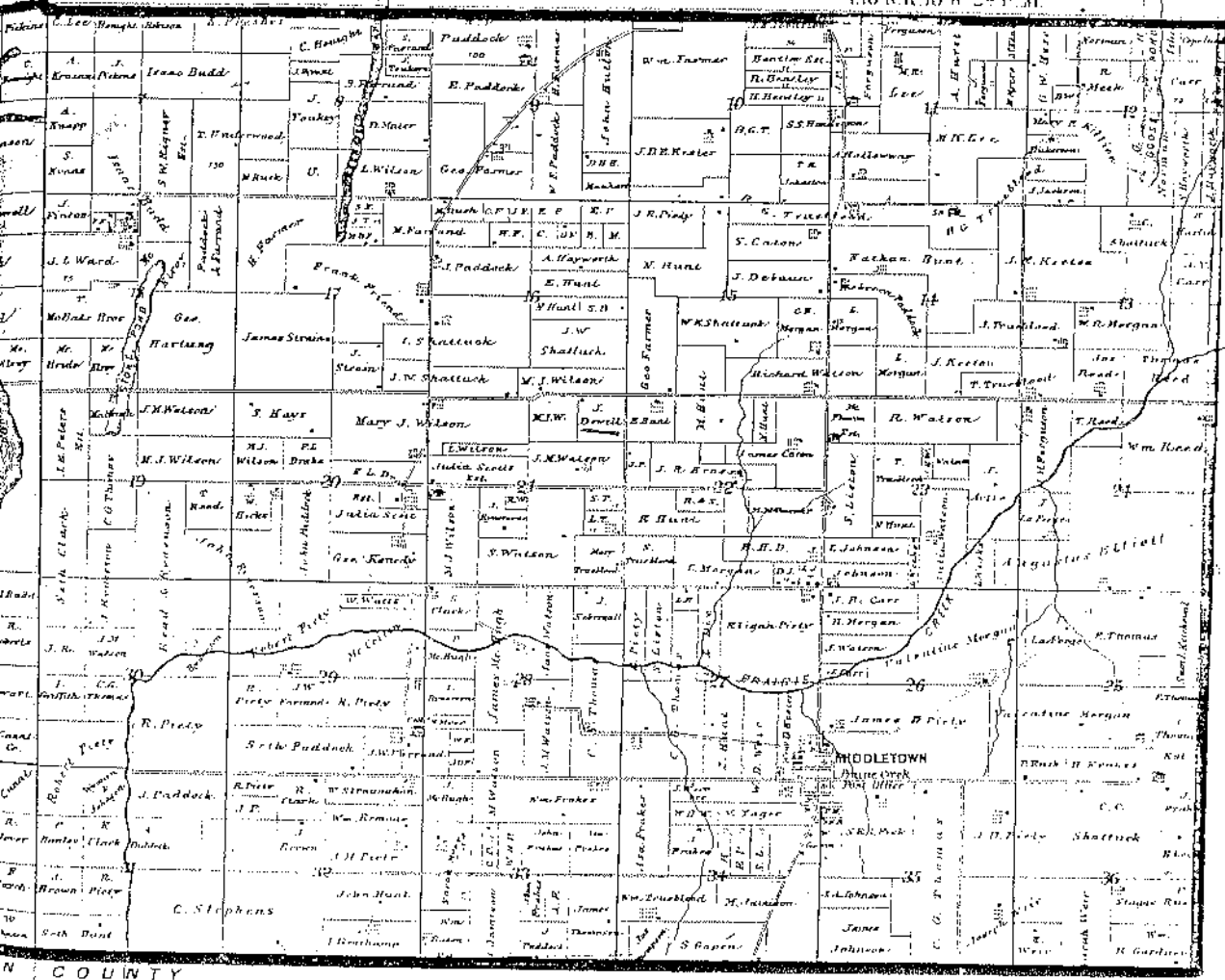

made the first settlement in this township. One of the first houses was built by James Piety now lives in 1816, at the first land sale in the county. Arm and Abijah Thomas, and Edmund Linton, were all settlers in 1816. William settled in the township soon after. Benson Trueland and Mitchell Simmons bought the Johnson place, where he now resides, and became a settler in 1826.

William Armstrong built the first mill. The first school house was built on the hill east of Middleton, in 1828. The first post-office was established on the old Army Road as early as 1838. David Lykens was Postmaster. There is now one post-office in this township, viz: Elizabeth Foster and Elizabeth Wilson. Schools: S. E. Fisk, Trustee; Districts, 8. One school school in one brick building at Middleton. This township contains some of the finest prairie farms in the county.

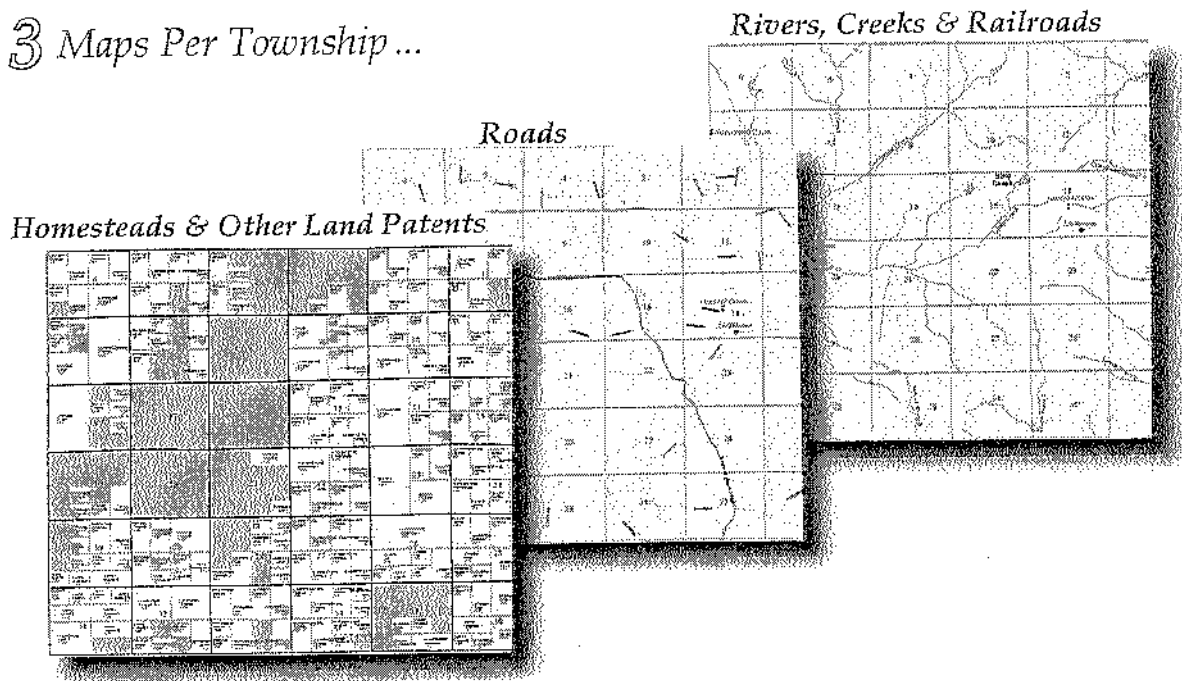

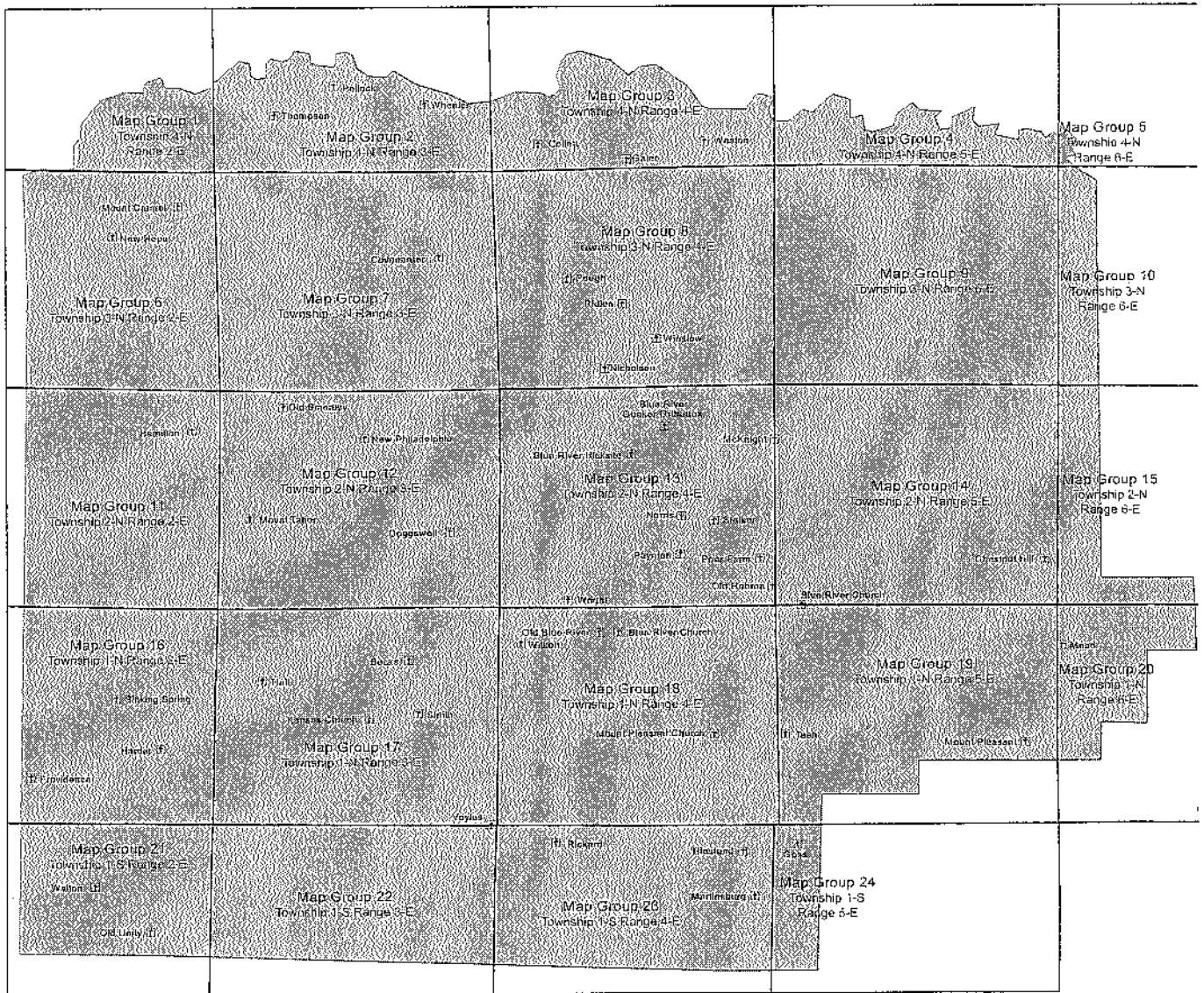

# Map E - Cemeteries of Washington County, Indiana



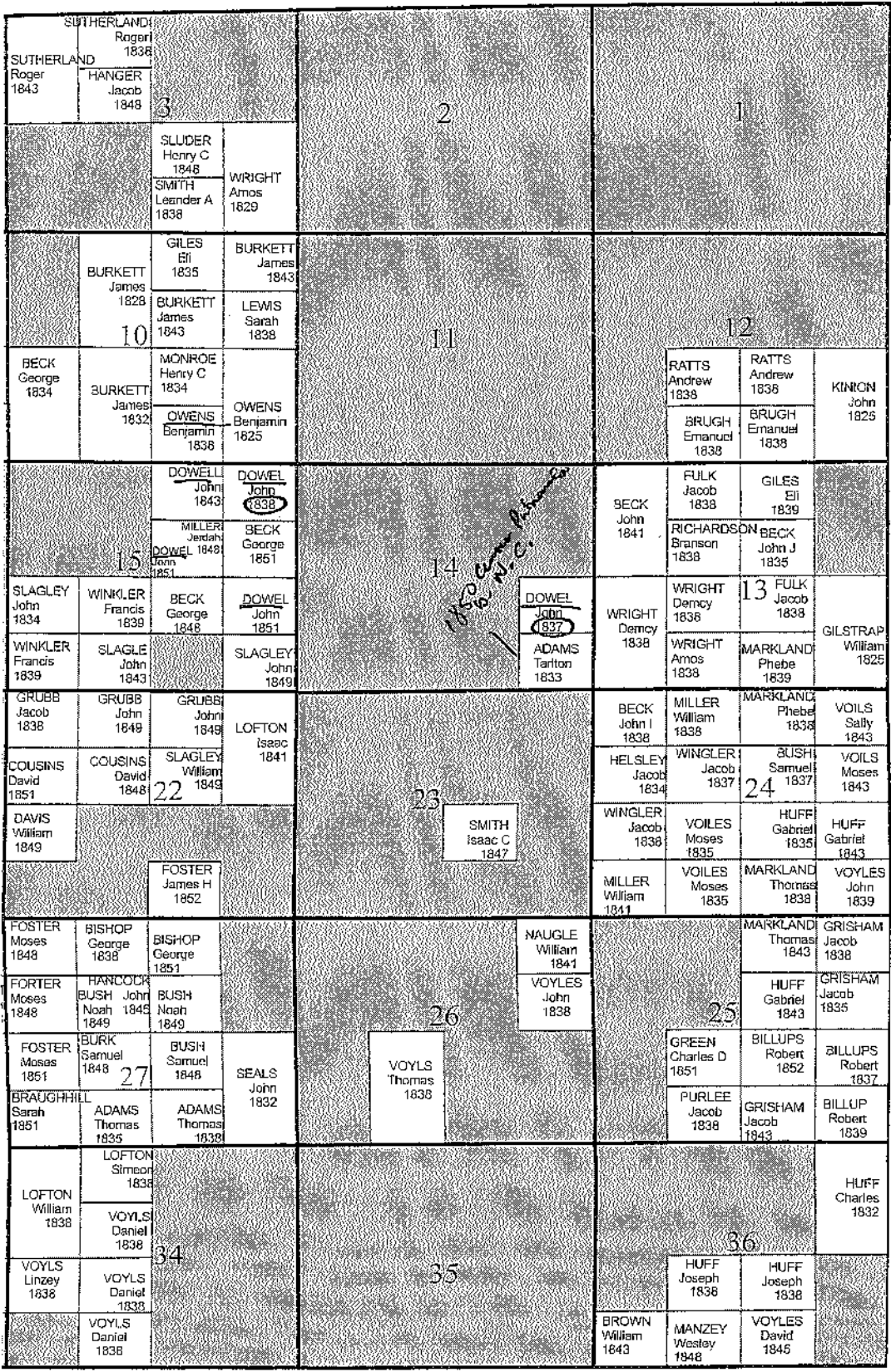

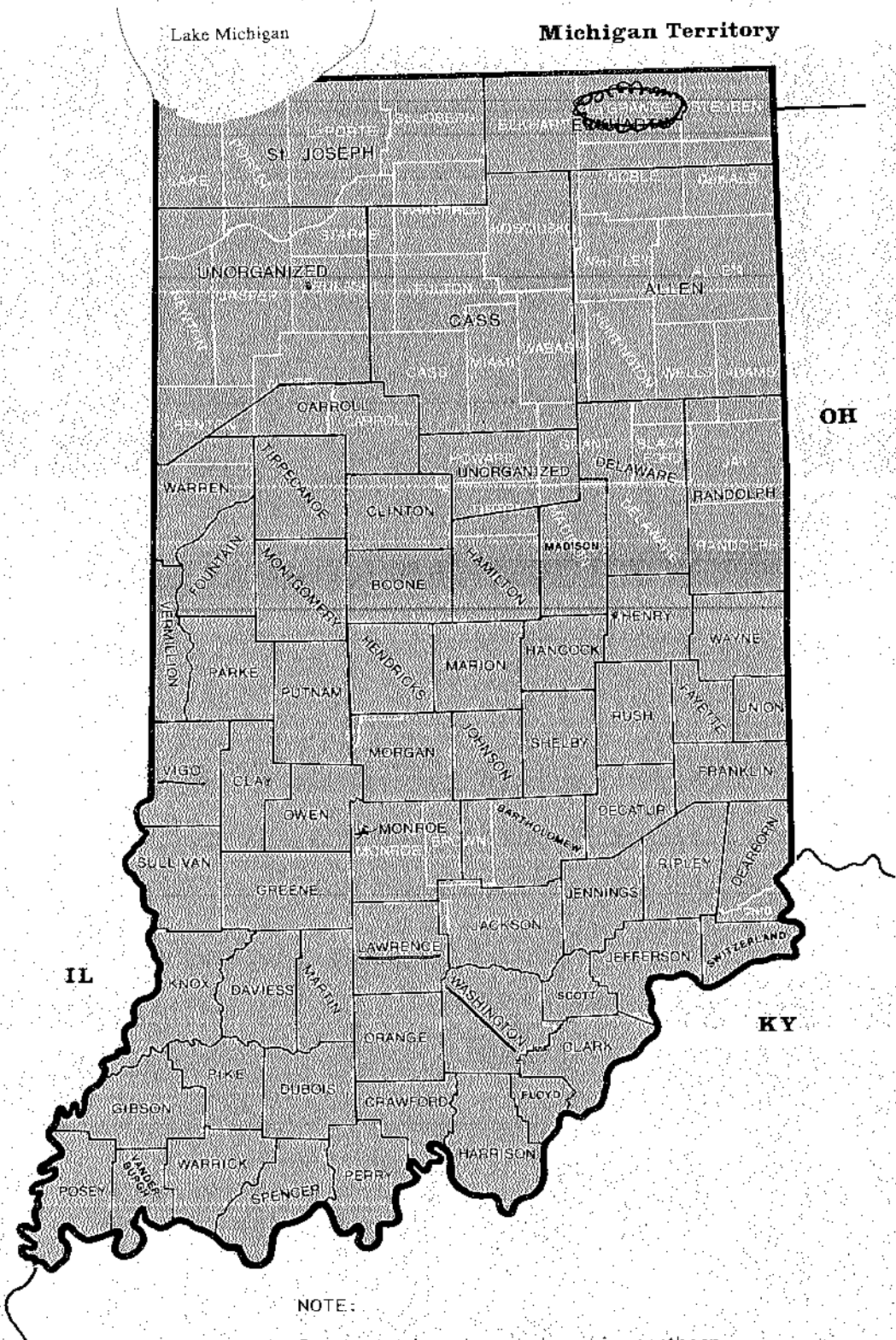
**Description:**

This database details those persons enumerated in the 1830 United States Federal Census, the Fifth Census of the United States. In addition, the names of those listed on the population schedule are linked to the actual images of the 1830 Federal Census. Enumerators of the 1830 census were asked to include the following categories in the census: name of head of household, number of free white males and females, number of other free persons, names of slave owners and number of slaves, number of foreigners, and town or district and county of residence.
