Thank you for your e-mail of 23 October 2006.

We do not hold any bastardy papers for Fleet, unfortunately. I have checked the index of Holland Sessions bastardy papers for any mention of Thomas Laughton but without success.

The Overseers accounts for Fleet are dated 1737 to 1764 only. We have vestry minute books listing dole to the poor of Fleet but these are dated 1835 to 1873, so are not relevant to your research.

I am sorry to have been unable to help on this occasion.
